Do NOT include the circled numbers in your listings.

Separate Each Numbered Section With ONE Carriage Return

1 Venue Name of theatre or gallery, etc. If you have more than one event, you do not have to repeat the 'Venue' for each event. Your events will be listed in sequence under the heading of the **Venue** – see the examples below.

2 Date(s) of Event If you have more than one event, list them in sequence for the two months starting with the month of the issue. Example: For the April issue, list all events for April & May.

Place the **Times** and **Days** of the Week in the **Description** [See # 4 Below]

3 Name of Event

4 Description **Limit the Description to a maximum of 75 words. Type one continuous paragraph for the Description. Do NOT use a carriage return except at the end of the paragraph.**

Include the **Times** and **Days** of the week – AND - Include the Ticket Price.

5 Contact Information Include Venue Address, Phone Number, E-mail & Website.
