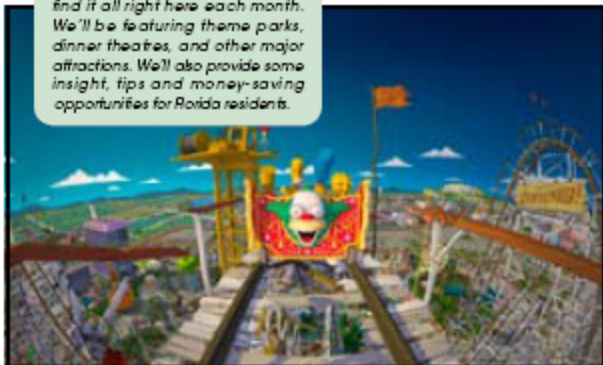


One Day Trip:
